Specifically, **1**) increase the benefit for catastrophic line of duty disability for Certified Law Officers from 30% to 45%, and for Correctional Officers from 0% to 35%, and for Correctional Officers from 0% to 35%, and for Correctional Officers and Correctional Officers from \$10,000 of annual earned income to \$30,000 of annual earned income.

The Commissioners may make amendments to the proposed legislation based upon the comments received at the hearing and may do so without further hearing. Therefore, it is important for interested persons to be present.
