From MD32 (Sykesville Road) - head east on Pine Knob Road which turns into Mineral Hill Road for 2.6 miles; turn right into the South Carroll Senior & Community Center; the South Carroll Dog Park will be on your right behind the Center.

From MD26 (Liberty Road) - turn onto Oklahoma Road; turn right onto Mineral Hill Road; turn right into the South Carroll Senior & Community Center; the South Carroll Dog Park will be on your right behind the Center.



SOUTH CARROLL DOG PARK

HOW DID THIS PROJECT BEGIN?

For many years, there have been a growing number of requests for a second County dog park. Recently, the Carroll County Commissioners approved a request to utilize land behind the South Carroll Senior & Community Center into a dog park. The Department of Recreation & Parks actively worked with dedicated volunteers to bring the project to fruition. SCDP is a "Members Only" facility. Member fees are used to maintain the grounds and amenities.

WHAT IS A DOG PARK?

South Carroll Dog Park is a large fenced in area where dogs are permitted to be taken off-leash to exercise and socialize with other dogs in a safe environment. This is the only area in any County park where dogs are permitted off-leash. Many backyards do not give dogs enough room to run. Veterinarians agree, exercise and socialization contribute to a well adjusted dog. Dog parks provide excellent opportunities for dog owners to socialize as well.

WHAT ARE THE PARK AMENITIES?

- Approximately two-acres of fenced in off-leash dog area
- Ample parking
- Benches and bowls are provided, but be sure to bring your own water

WHAT ARE THE MEMBERSHIP DETAILS?

The annual membership to SCDP is \$30. Proof of rabies vaccination and dog license are required. Applications can be found on the Department of Recreation & Parks website at ccrecpark.org.

HOW IS THE PARK FUNDED?

Construction and maintenance of the park is dependent on contributions and paid memberships from dog lovers like you. Donations from community members raised over \$20,000 for ground preparation, fencing, signage, and other start-up costs. Donations will be used for park maintenance and other site improvements.
