BABYLON ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

DESCRIPTION

The Babylon Road bridge replacement project includes replacing the existing bridge with a new structure. The structure crosses over Silver Run in northwestern Carroll County. The new bridge will be designed to handle all the current legal vehicles.

Design of the new structure is underway, and construction is planned for fall of 2019. Traffic will be detoured around the work zone when construction commences.

Federal funds from the Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program will cover 80-percent of the design and construction costs.

UPDATES

January 2, 2018:

The additional analysis is complete and has been shared with MD State Highway Administration for comment.

August 14, 2017:

Notice to proceed with the preliminary evaluation of alternatives was given September 12, 2016. Environmental assessment, hydraulic analysis and structure type have been studied. Because the 100-year floodplain of Silver Run encompasses the entire site, additional analysis was needed to make sure floodplain impacts were avoided.
