CAPE HORN ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

DESCRIPTION

The Cape Horn Road bridge replacement project includes replacing the existing bridge with a new single cell concrete box culvert. The structure crosses over an unnamed stream in eastern Carroll County, near the Harvey Gummel Road intersection. The new bridge will be designed to handle all the current legal vehicles.

Design of the new structure is underway, and construction is planned for summer of 2018. Traffic will be detoured around the work zone when construction commences.

Completing this project will reduce maintenance costs and provide a structurally sufficient bridge for many years.

UPDATES

August 22, 2018:

The project was advertised for construction bids in June 2018. Bids were opened on June 27, 2018. After review, Public Works recommended award to the lowest responsive bidder. The Board of Commissioners approved the recommendation. Contract award is complete.

The traffic detour will be effective August 22, 2018. Final utility relocations will be underway soon, after which the existing structure will be removed and construction of the new structure will begin.

February 12, 2018:

The final review set of contract documents were submitted for review mid-January. Environmental permitting is in process.

Land acquisition for needed rights-of-way and easements is complete.
