

**ORDINANCE No. 2020-03**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS AND ORDINANCES OF CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND**

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland (“the Board”), has enacted and codified the "Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, Maryland";

**WHEREAS**, the Board is charged under State law with the duty and responsibility for establishing comprehensive policies and programs to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the County and accordingly deems the subject amendment necessary to accomplish these duties and responsibilities; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland:

**ARTICLE I. AMENDMENTS.**

**Section 1.** The Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, Title VII, Traffic Code, Chapter 71, School Bus Monitoring Cameras, is added as follows:

**§ 71.01 SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS.**

(A) **Definition.** As used in this section, “School Bus Monitoring Camera” has the meaning set forth in § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

(B) **Use authorized.** The use of school bus monitoring cameras in accordance with § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland is authorized in Carroll County.

**ARTICLE II. SEVERABILITY.**

Should any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this ordinance be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence,

clause, or part of this ordinance, it being the intent of the County Commissioners that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

**ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall become effective on May 8, 2020.
