The County Commissioners of Carroll County will hold a **virtual** public hearing on Thursday, September 17, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. to hear public comments on a proposed amendment to the Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, Title III, Administration, which would create Chapter 37, Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services. Specifically, Chapter 37 would establish a department of County government and a director of that department, which would be responsible for the full scope of fire prevention, fire suppression, hazardous material, emergency medical services, and other related public safety functions provided to Carroll County and its municipalities. Participating individual volunteer fire and rescue organizations and the Carroll County Volunteer Emergency Services Association (CCVESA) would operate as organizational components of the department.
