	b. <u>Veteran's Shuttle Report</u> (Stacey Nash) – July 2020:
	i. 16 veterans were served and 14 home pick-ups
	1. Baltimore – 8 veterans served with 12 trips

	3. Loch Raven – 1 veteran served with 1 trip
	 Martinsburg – 3 veterans served with 3 trips
	5. Total cost - \$3,082
	ii. The VA is beginning to open so trips are starting to be scheduled.
	c. Employment Initiatives for Veterans Update (John Veney) – John reported that he worked with 13
	veterans with four finding employment this month. He thanked Gina and Francine for their assistance
	with a homeless veteran. Gina thanked Francine for her case management of a veteran.
4.	<u>Update on Veteran Direct Home and Community Based Services Program Grant</u> (Francine Hahn) – Currently
	there is one vacancy in the program.
5.	<u>Update on Veteran Services Program Grant</u> (Francine Hahn) – Currently three are in a hotel with one approved
	for HUD-VASH. Assistance has been provided in the search for an apartment, applying for HUD-VASH and the
	needs of a veteran and their family. Currently supplies of household items are needed.
6.	Executive Committee (Marc Fisher) – The Executive Committee will be meeting soon to gather resources and
	information for the Veterans portion of the upcoming Aging & Disabilities Resource Guide.
7.	<u>Census 2020 Update</u> – Staff has received good guidance on the counting of homeless individuals which will take
	place in September. Carroll County's response rate is still the highest in Maryland. Continue to encourage
	everyone to take the census and currently workers are visiting addresses that have not yet responded. Outreach
	events have been scheduled for two historically low count areas in Carroll County, New Windsor and Union
