ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS Feeser Road (From Trevanion Road to Crouse Mill Road)

The Commissioners of Carroll County, in a continued effort to maintain the County roadway system, has recently approved a multi-road paving contract which includes your roadway. This contract has been awarded to C.J. Miller LLC. We anticipate this contract starting in the Spring and continuing through Fall, contingent upon any weather-related events.

This paving contract includes the following: For

- Full Depth Reclamation (FDR)
- Driveway tie-ins adjustments if necessary
- Restoration of any grassy areas that were disturbed during work

Prior to Work:

- Please remove all private property items such as landscaping decorations, flowers and/or shrubs that may be within the county right-of-way and/or shoulder area until the work is complete.
- If you have any property corners within the road or shoulder area, that may be disturbed during this work, please contact our office so we can reference these. Any corners not mentioned will not be reset.

During the work:

- There will be heavy equipment and dump trucks in the work zones.
- Continuous traffic will be maintained but restricted to one lane during this work and will be controlled by lane closures and flagging operations. Delays in traffic, up to 15 minutes, are possible.
- A Carroll County Construction Inspector will be onsite to ensure the contractor meets County and State Specifications.
