

RESOLUTION No. _____-2021

9-1-1 SERVICE -- ADDITIONAL FEE

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland (“the County”), are authorized by § 1-311 of the Public Safety Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to adopt an additional charge for 9-1-1 service that is in addition to the State’s 9-1-1 fee; and

WHEREAS, the County’s current additional charge is set at .75 cents; and

WHEREAS, during FY2020, the County’s operational costs for the 9-1-1 service exceeded revenues collected at the current rate by \$1,625,521.00; and

WHEREAS, the County conducted a public hearing on May 6, 2021 for the purpose of addressing the deficit in the operation of the 9-1-1 service by increasing the additional charge from .75 cents to \$1.50, the maximum allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County, that the additional charge for 9-1-1 service currently set at .75 cents is increased to \$1.50.
