	4. <u>Commissioner's Report</u> –
	a. Commissioner Rothstein reported that the Veterans home to be built in the South Carroll area continues to
	move forward. He recently visited the hospital and hospice and met with Garrett Hoover, CEO to discuss the
	hospice expansion and their veteran programs. They brainstormed a Veterans keepsake to be included in
	the Hospice expansion. He is proud of the work that we are doing within our community and partnerships.
	Vaccinations are occurring and we are challenged with the numbers. If you have the opportunity to get
	vaccinated then get vaccinated. The Health Department is in phase 1B and should be moving to 1C (65+) in a
	week or two. Hospital and pharmacies are in phase 1C and Walter Reed is vaccinating veterans. Marc noted
	that Lifebridge Hospital in Randallstown is also providing vaccinations. Commissioner Rothstein shared that
	the Board is getting ready to move into the budget season.
	b. At last month's meeting it was discussed the lack of awareness of the programs offered for Veterans in
	Carroll County. Commissioner Weaver would like to use his monthly WTTR podcast to interview VAC
	members as they promote different programs for Veterans in the county. He would also like to tape an
	episode that can be used if one of the Commissioners are unable to record during their scheduled time. He

	in other counties. Stacey Nash reported that they have discussed and determined it would be better
	if additional counties supplied a veteran shuttle first so they could share the transportation routes.
	c. <u>Employment Initiatives for Veterans Update</u> (John Veney) – There will be a Veterans Benefits Fair on April
	20, 2021 with information for veterans and caregivers on all benefits that are available to them. A flyer will
	be forwarded to the group for help in distribution. Nationwide unemployment rate for veterans was 5.2% in
	February, which is up from 4.9% in January. Their goal is to decrease the veteran unemployment to 3.1%
	which was pre-COVID. The state added 6,800 jobs last month and they use a rough estimate of 10% for
	veterans. He was able to assist seven veterans find employment last month. He is still working remotely but
	any veteran can call and set up an appointment with BERC.
	4. <u>Update on Veteran Direct Home and Community Based Services Program Grant</u> (Francine Hahn) – Currently they
	are serving three veterans.
	5. <u>Update on Veteran Services Program Grant</u> (Francine Hahn) – An update on the two veterans that are in the
	hotel – one is a multi-generational family who will be moving to alternative housing on Thursday and the other is
	remaining and working on a HUD-VASH voucher. A veteran who previously received the donation of a car that
	was in need of some car repairs was assisted by a local veteran-owned service center. A South Carroll church is
	assisting a legally blind veteran with home repairs. Francine had an intake with a new homeless veteran who is
	not VA eligible. He was honorably discharged four months shy of two years. She is assisting him in applying for
	service compensation. At the last Ending Veteran Homelessness meeting they were able to identify a few
	veterans that were utilizing the Night-by-Night Shelter.
New Business	1. <u>Veterans View in the Carroll County Times – Marc Fisher.</u> Marc has created a rotation of four writers for the
	monthly Veterans View column. He submitted March with "Do you know a Veteran?", Todd Mitchell will be
