## **SWEF Property Acquisition**

Property Acquisition September 24, 2021

Existing Property: 220 Acres

Acquired Property: 326 Acres\*

Total SWEF Property: 546 Acres

108.99\* acres retained by prior owner

\*Land acquired does not follow some existing property lines and requires consolidation or subdivision

#### **Next Steps:**

#### **Property Boundary Survey**

- Confirm property corners, lines, easements/ROW's
- Seller retained parcel consolidation
- Confirm farm lease areas
- Required for Master Planning process
- Anticipated start: December 2021



### **SWEF Master Plan Update**

#### Master Plan Study / Development:

- RFP Scope under development w/NMWDA
- Includes ESA's, natural resources, historical records, utilities, subsurface studies

### Sustainable Future for Carroll County

- Landfill, replacement transfer station, upgraded public drop-off, improved entrance & internal traffic flow
- Waste diversion alternatives, new technologies, long term planning
