

If you or someone in your household have experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19 and are behind on your rent, the Emergency Rental Assistance Program, recently established by the U.S. Treasury, may be able to help.

## Who is eligible?

You must be renting in Carroll County.

You must have been impacted by COVID-19.

Your household income must be under:

## What will you need to apply?

Copy of your current lease or rental agreement

Proof of household income

Proof of the amount of rent you owe

## Tell us how COVID hurt your household, for example:

- Unemployment
- Reduced hours at work
- Lack of childcare
- COVID illness
- Medical costs
- Caring for someone with COVID
