CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Paul Noyes at the County Office Building, Westminster.

A copy of the minutes from November 23, 2021, meeting was emailed to each board member. Mr. Noyes asked the Board if they will accept the minutes as written. Mr. Brosenne made a motion to accept the minutes and Mr. Sullivan seconded the motion, the vote was unanimously carried by the Board.

NO OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board discussed adopting the 2023 Electrical Code instead of the 2020 Electrical Code. Mr. Green mentioned he thinks we should move forward with the 2020 Electrical Code on January 1, 2023. Mr. Green also stated that the board should review the 2023 Electrical Codes to see if there are any major changes. He informed the Board that the Board of

Commissioners may inquire what the changes are using the 2017 Electrical Code opposed to the 2020 Electrical Code. Mr. Brosenne made a motion to remain with the 2017 Electrical Code for the remainder of the year and move forward with the 2021 Electrical Code on January 1, 2023.

Mr. Harris mentioned that the Electrical Bylaws will need to be changed regarding the verbiage, changing the wording of LICENSE to REGISTRATION. Mr. Brosenne made a motion to go ahead with the changes and Mr. Sullivan seconded the motion.

ELECTRICAL RESTRICTED AND LIMITED REGISTRATION EXAM:

The board discussed selecting the questions for the examination of the restricted and limited registrations. The board decided to use the questions from the previous examination.

The next meeting will be held on April 19, 2022, to administer the Electrical Limited and Restricted Exam at Carroll County Office Building, Room 124C. Mr. Brosenne made a motion for the meeting to adjourn, and Mr. Sullivan seconded the motion and was unanimously carried by the Board.
