#### **Nature Center Membership**

Members of either the Piney Run Recreation and Conservation Council and/or the Friends of Hashawha/Bear Branch play an important role in providing additional financial and volunteer support for their respective facilities. As a Nature Center member, you receive discounts on nature shop items, mailing of the quarterly Recreation & Parks Program Guide listing programs offered at both Nature Centers and at various other locations throughout Carroll County, as well as an invitation to exclusive Members-Only programs. Use the Nature Center Membership form on page 2 to apply for your 2019 membership. This Nature Center Membership is NOT the same as a Park Vehicle Season Pass for Piney Run Park.

NOTE: To be eligible for the early Members Only Registration dates as well as any Summer Camp discounts for programs listed in this booklet, your <u>current</u>\* membership must be one of the following: Family or Lifetime (Senior, Full Time Student, and Individual memberships <u>do not</u> qualify for Summer Nature Camp benefits).

NEW... Your membership is valid through the calendar year in which you purchased it .i.e.: 2019 memberships are valid January 2019 through December 2019. You must already have a 2019 membership at the time of submitting your camp registration or it will be returned to you as not eligible (see form on page 2).

The Americans with Disabilities Act applies to the Carroll County Government and its programs, services, activities and facilities. #### **Registration Information**

#### **IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

Registrations will be processed on a first-come, first-serve basis with FULL PAYMENT. Since our summer camps fill quickly, we highly recommend you register early. Parents must fully complete the <u>Carroll County Dept. of Recreation & Parks</u> Registration Form (use a separate form for each child) on page 6 or register online at ccrecpark.org. Incomplete forms will NOT be accepted until they are fully completed delaying your child's enrollment in camp. Use program numbers listed under each week of camp.

- Registration begins for <u>Nature Center Members</u> on February 1st for Piney Run & March 8th for Bear Branch. (Members may not register Non-members).
- ⇒ Registration begins for all <u>Non-members</u> on March 16th for Piney Run & March 15th for Bear Branch.
- ⇒ Forms that are postmarked before February 1 (PRNC) or March 8 (BBNC) (Members), or March 16 (PRNC) or March 15 (BBNC) (Non-members) will be returned to sender.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Parents whose child is registered in Camp will be mailed a camp packet containing additional forms for completion, and important camp information. Please hold onto camp information until your child complete his/her full camp session. If your registration is received after a camp is filled, you will be notified and added to that camp's wait list. The payment will be returned in full if your child cannot be placed. Should an applicant withdraw from camp, substitutes from that camp's wait list will be contacted at that time.

#### PINEY RUN CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

A limited number of scholarships are available for those qualifying for financial assistance for a Piney Run Camp week. Contact PRNC for an application as soon as possible; scholarship application deadline is May 1, 2019.

#### **REFUNDS**

- If your child cannot be placed, your full amount paid will be refunded.
- If a camper withdraws at least 10 days prior to camp start date, a refund will be provided less a 20% administrative fee.
- ◆ If a camper withdraws less than 10 days prior to camp start date, NO refund will be issued, no exceptions.
- No refunds will be issued if your child/ren is dismissed from camp for behavioral problems.
- Some camp weeks have minimum enrollment requirements. If, for any reason, these minimums are not reached, then the specific camp in question could be canceled. In such case, a full refund will be processed.

#### **WHO CAN ATTEND**

Piney Run Summer Nature Camp is for GRADES Kindergarten thru 6th (completed by June 2019). Bear Branch Summer Nature Camp is for AGES 6-11. Campers <u>cannot</u> be placed ahead or behind their grade level—no exceptions. For your preschool aged children, please see our Preschool Discovery Week listed in the Carroll County Recreation & Parks 2019 Summer Program Guide at ccrecpark.org (released mid-April). For teens in grades 7th-10th, see page 4 of this brochure for the Department of Recreation & Parks "Teens on the Go!" program offerings.

#### **OUR STAFF**

All groups will have a maximum of 20 campers per age group and are supervised by a qualified Senior Counselor, a high school or college aged Junior Counselor, and 1 to 3 volunteers.

Pack a lunch daily with plenty of water, including a snack, in an insulated bag. Freezing a water bottle filled 1/2 full, and then filled to the top in the morning helps provide cold drinking water throughout their day.

- Campers MUST wear close-toed shoes at all times. Crocs and water shoes are only allowed during the canoeing and other water sports. Absolutely no sandals!
- Bug spray is very important as the campers will spend most of the day outdoors. We make every effort to avoid insect bites however, there are ticks and other insects in the park so it is wise to check your camper daily.
- ♦ Apply sunblock on your child daily—we are outside and not always shaded!
- Piney Run ONLY Friday's lunch: Subway will be sponsoring a box lunch choice of \$6/meal (includes 6-inch sub, cookie and bag of chips), or a \$8/meal (includes a foot-long sub, cookie and bag of chips); with drinks provided by Piney Run Park. Pre-orders will be due at camper pickup on Wednesday. Those choosing not to order a Subway Box Lunch will need to bring their own bagged lunch.

#### PINEY RUN CAMP DATES & TIMES

- ♦ Monday-Friday, 9:30am-3:30pm (with the exception of Groups 4 & 5 for Friday evening cookout, and Group 6 Friday overnights)
- Drop-off and pick-up is held at the Tennis Courts.
- Campers will be placed in groups according to grade completed by June 2019 sorry, no exceptions.

Sessions are: Week 1: July 8-12, Week: July 15-19, Week 3: July 22-26, and Week 4: July 29-August 2

NOTE: on FRIDAY OF EACH WEEK at 3pm, we will hold a "SHOW-OFFs" time at the Amphitheater in the Park. Campers will show off what they learned for parents and family members - it is a great time for the campers and their families to share! Campers will then go home with parents at its completion (with the exception of Groups 4, 5 and 6).

#### PINEY RUN EARLY DROP-OFF / LATE PICK-UP

Piney Run Park will provide early drop-off from 8-9:30am, and late pick-up from 3:30-5pm each day of camp at Pavilion #5 in the Park. The cost is \$10/session (AM or PM), or \$15/day for both AM and PM, or \$70/week for both AM and PM. This service is provided by park staff, camp counselors and/or volunteers. Registration for this additional service is required at least one week prior to your child's camp start date. Please contact PRNC for the required registration form needed to apply. \*\*NOTE: A \$10/per child late fee will be assessed for every 15 minutes after 5pm for those campers not yet picked up - no exceptions!

Payment must be made at time of registration (Visa, MasterCard, Discover) -ORcall R&P 410-386-2103 Monday-Friday 8am-5pm, using your credit card. All online and phone registrations are processed immediately and payment confirmation is sent via email.

Mail It In: Complete registration form and mail along with your check (payable to Carroll County Commissioners) to address noted on the bottom of the form (NO cash/ credit card payments via mail). Provide all information requested on the form to ensure prompt processing. No confirmation will be sent; your canceled check is your receipt.

Walk It In: You may register in person Monday-Friday 8am-5pm with cash, credit card, or check payment at Carroll County Department of Recreation & Parks, located in the Robert Moton Center, 300 S. Center Street, Westminster.


