Maryland Legal Aid (MLA) is the largest provider of free, direct legal services in Maryland and the state's 3rd largest law firm\*. As a private, non-profit law firm, MLA provides a full range of free civil legal services to low-income people statewide, in Baltimore City and in Maryland's 23 counties, from 12 office locations. Financial support for our services comes from federal, state and local governments, foundations, law firms, the United Way, and from individual donors.

MLA handles civil (not criminal) cases involving a wide range of issues, including child custody, housing, public benefits, consumer law (e.g., bankruptcy and debt collection and criminal record expungements to remove barriers to obtaining child custody, housing, and employment.

Many of MLA's local offices represent children in CINA (Child in Need of Assistance) proceedings. Other vulnerable populations, such as victims of abuse and domestic violence, seniors, migrant farmworkers, veterans, and nursing home and assisted living residents, also receive specialized representation. MLA's services include representation before federal and state trial and appellate courts, brief advice and counsel, and referrals to other sources of assistance.

### Pickleball Committee Update

The Kitchen Report November Hello Everyone,

We held our first Pickleball Tournament on October 17, 2025. Thank you to the volunteers and to the 24 participants who made this tournament a success. Congratulations to our winners! All proceeds from the tournament benefit the South Carroll Senior Center Site Council.

We continue to reserve 1 court on Wednesday mornings from 9:30 am to 10:30 am for beginners up to level 2.5 (0-2.5). Remember it's important to check in upon arrival so the Center knows the number of people that use the facility (gym).

The Pickleball Theory Class for beginners is offered on Thursday afternoons between 1:00 PM and 2:30 PM. The class is held when there are 6 people registered by Tuesday of each week. The class will be deferred from week to week until we have at least 6 people registered. The class covers most areas necessary to become familiar with the game. There's a visual court and net set up so people can see and understand the different explanations of what goes on during a game. After the class, the students are invited into the gym to actually play on a court with the Beginner/Intermediate group. Bring a paddle if you have one. There is no charge for this class. Please register at the front desk.

We received permission to change the date for annual pickleball dues collection from January of each year to October of each year. This change means that collection of pickleball dues will now coincide with the timetable of filling out yearly registration forms at the Center. The dues remain \$20.00 for 2026. With this change, we hope to reduce the daily time demand on the volunteers taking care of the front desk, while making it easier for people joining the center and playing pickleball. We understand that paying earlier may put a financial strain on some players, especially those who joined recently, but the cost for one year at the center is much cheaper than the cost at private pickleball facilities. Thank you for your understanding with this change.

We have also received permission for visitors of registered South Carroll Senior Center pick-leball players to pay a daily fee of \$5.00 each visit. Unfortunately, they still will have to fill out the registration paperwork for the center. This \$5.00 fee will be noted at each visit and after 4 visits (\$20.00) the visitor will be considered a fully paid member of the pickleball group. They may now play the rest of the year at no cost.
