10.	Place a note on plan that says, "When tube shelters are used, they must be removed prior to release of bond money."	
11.	The planting schedule for completion of planting as shown in 115-10(C) of the Code must be on the plan.	
12.	The survival rate required at the end of the maintenance period must be placed on the plan – refer to pg. A-19 of the Forest Conservation Technical Manual.	
13.	A person required to conduct afforestation or reforestation on-site shall accomplish the afforestation or reforestation contemporaneous with the removal of sediment control devices.	
14.	A person authorized to conduct afforestation or reforestation off-site shall accomplish the afforestation or reforestation within one (1) year or two (2) growing seasons of the issuance of the grading permit.
