Date – Use the given date

Fentanyl, Midazolam, Ketorolac – Used the tracking numbers from the issued cards.

Total Amount- is the total amount on unit for each medication

Amount Given – Amount administered to patient

Amount Wasted – Amount wasted from the vial or syringe used

eMeds Inc. number- eMeds incident number from the call you used the medication

## Signature 1

- a. Daily Checks on coming ALS clinician
- b. Medication used ALS clinician using medication

## Signature 2

- a. Daily Checks Off Going ALS clinician who was responsible for the medication the day prior
- b. Medication Wasted Nurse, Clinician, FD Officer, who ever witnessed the wasting of medication.
