Carroll County begins pilot recycling program for vinyl siding

February 26, 2009 – Carroll County Recycling Office is beginning a vinyl siding collection program. Vinyl siding will be accepted in a designated container, free of charge, from Carroll County residents at the Recycling Center drop-off area of the Northern Landfill, 1400 Baltimore Boulevard, Westminster. Painted siding, foam-backed siding, siding with nylon nail hem and siding with a fiberglass rod insert can not be accepted. Businesses may call the landfill at 410-386-4550 to see if they are eligible to participate and coordinate their drop-off.

Hours of operation for the Northern Landfill are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. For additional information, call Maria Myers, Carroll County Government Recycling Manager, at 410-386-2035 or the Northern Landfill at 410-386-4550.
