Health Department Seeks Help to Find Dog

Westminster, MD (April 4, 2018) – The Carroll County Health Department is asking area residents for help in finding a dog that bit a person on Sunday, April 1st around 1:00 PM, outside the Cup Tea Bar & Cafe in Westminster on East Main Street and Railroad Avenue/Route 27.

The dog was described as being a medium-sized mixed lab. It had a medium-length black coat with straight fur and was being walked with four poodle-type dogs. According to the Health Department, it is likely that the victim of the attack will be treated with a series of post-exposure rabies shots if the dog has not been found and verified to be in good health by the morning of April 11th.
