## Joint Commissioner/Planning Commission Meeting Planned for June 11th

**Westminster, MD, Tuesday, May 29, 2018** – The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and the Planning and Zoning Commission (PZC) will host a joint meeting on June 11<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm in Room 003 of the County Office Building. During this meeting, the Boards will discuss the remanded Freedom Plan and the changes made by the PZC to comply with the commissioners' requests.

The updated plan was released to the public on May 9<sup>th</sup>, beginning the 60-day comment period. The 60-day public comment period will conclude with a Public Hearing scheduled on July 11, 2018 from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm, at the Liberty High School Auditorium.

The plan is posted on the [freedomareaplan.org](http://freedomareaplan.org) website along with an [interactive Future Land Use map](#) and a list of properties with a land use change from the 2001 Freedom Plan.

Citizens are invited to attend the Public Hearing to comment on the plan. They may also comment by:
