Official Carroll County Regional Airport Website Unveiled

Westminster, MD, Tuesday, December 5, 2017 - The Board of Carroll County Commissioners is pleased to unveil the new official [Carroll County Regional Airport](#) website. Carroll County Regional Airport, FAA designation KDMW, is a publicly owned, public use general aviation airport owned by Carroll County and located in Westminster along the MD 97 corridor. The new website highlights the airport's facilities and services along with providing links to important aviation resources and the fixed-based operator, Skytech, Inc.

Carroll County Regional Airport (CCRA) maintains a single 5,100-foot long by 100-foot wide runway; it is the sixth largest non-military runway in Maryland. As a reliever airport for Baltimore Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport, it is the place to land and fuel for many local flying enthusiasts.
