



Tobacco Use Prevention Grants Available

Westminster, MD (August 22, 2017) The Cigarette Restitution Fund Program of the Carroll County Health Department is offering tobacco use prevention grants of up to \$4000 to fund non-traditional projects with community-wide benefit. These grants give community organizations, businesses and other groups an opportunity to have direct input and influence on improving the health of Carroll County residents.

The project goals and objectives must fit into one of the following categories:

- 1) Implementing a tobacco-free campus for a business or organization;
- 2) Engaging and empowering youth in anti-tobacco awareness campaigns; or
- 3) Preventing secondhand smoke exposure in youth.
