# CONNECTING WITH YOUTH WHO ARE ON THEIR OWN AND EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS IN CARROLL COUNTY

**Westminster, Tuesday, March 07, 2017** – Youth REACH MD, a coalition of state and local partners, is conducting a youth outreach effort in **Carroll County March 12**<sup>th</sup> **through March 25**<sup>th</sup> to better understand and address youth homelessness.

The Youth REACH (Reach out, Engage, Assist, and Count to end Homelessness) MD Coalition will launch a survey and census of youth and young adults, **aged 13-24**, in Carroll County who are on their own and experiencing homelessness or housing instability. These youth are at an increased risk for victimization, exploitation, poor physical and behavioral health, substance use, and other adverse outcomes. The goal of the project is to better understand the number, characteristics, and needs of these youth in order to inform policy and resource provision and improve outcomes for youth and young adults in Carroll County and throughout the state of Maryland.

In order to complete the surveys during the two week period, trained Youth Ambassadors, along with county agencies, will interview those youth who are homeless, couch surfing, or otherwise unstably housed and on their own. Youth can also call the Youth REACH hotline (information below) to arrange to be counted in person or over the phone. Youth Reach Carroll will also be hosting two events focused on disconnected youth to inform them of available services.

On Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup> between 7:30 and 11 am, Youth REACH volunteers will be hosting information sessions at On Our Own (265 E. Main St.). A Free Breakfast will be available for all who attend along with the chance for youth to win prizes.

On Thursday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> between 11am and 1 pm, a Resource Fair will be held during the regularly scheduled community meal at St. Paul's UCC (17 Bond St.). Please attend for information about resources, giveaways and prize drawings.
