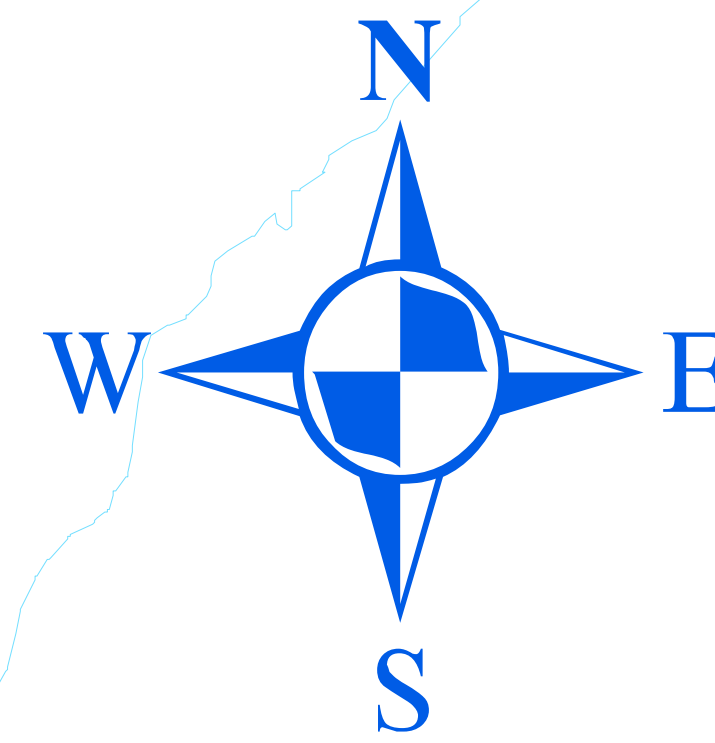

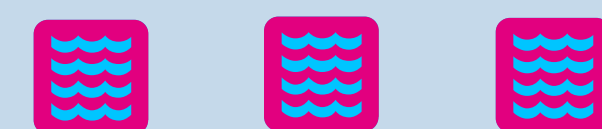

INFORMATION

Welcome to Carroll County's Water Trail. It is recommended that you check water levels online at the U.S. Geological Survey gauge number 01639500 Big Pipe Creek at Bruceville, MD. The level should read 100 cubic feet per second (cfs) or show a water level of at least 1.4 feet. Also for your convenience we have painted a marker on the river right bridge abutment at Hapes Mill which is an approximation of these levels.

Please keep in mind that this is just a guideline and that Big Pipe Creek and Double Pipe Creek do reach hazardous flood stages after rain events. The National Weather Service reports flooding and related hazards for both the Monocacy and Potomac Rivers on local media outlets.

As with any river canoeing you must always be aware of strainers and downed trees that may block your passage and require that you portage around the obstacle. We also ask that while enjoying this river trail that you are respectful of private property. Always Wear Approved Flotation Vests!
