## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

On February 25, 2003, the Board of Zoning Appeals (the Board) convened to hear the request for a conditional use to establish a contractor's equipment storage facility. Based on the testimony and evidence presented, the Board made the following findings and conclusion:

The subject property is currently a vacant parcel in the North Carroll Industrial Center. It is in an area zoned "I-G" General Industrial. The Applicant wishes to build a metal steel building (90 Ft. x 40 Ft.) on a slab foundation with three garage bays and utilities. He wishes to store contractors' equipment at the site for his underground utility inspection and repair service. His equipment includes trailers and trucks used in his business. The property is well screened from the public and roads. The Applicant expects two employees to work at the site, with hours from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The Board finds that the proposed use at this location will not generate adverse effects above and beyond those normally associated with a contractor's equipment storage yard. It is compatible with the neighborhood and will generate minimal traffic and noise. Accordingly, the conditional use is granted.
