### **Update on Employment Initiatives for Veterans** (Jennifer Gensler)

- 15 Veterans on case load last month, with 200 activity codes (helping with employment referrals, resume).
- 1 person found employment for the month of September.
- Very busy overall

### **Update on Veteran Services Program Grant** (Bobbie Lawrence)

- Tony Roman continues to provide case management to Veterans experiencing financial hardship and homelessness
- Currently providing emergency housing to a Veteran and his spouse who will be moving to Bo. county with a VASH voucher in November.
- Working with the VFW Auxiliary to identify Veterans in long term care facilities who would benefit from visits from other Veterans
- The SSVF program through Sheppard Pratt has now been transferred to "Friendship Place" a program based in DC that manages a "Veteran's First" program. Bobbie will continue to attempt to connect with the Maryland liaison.
- Gina Valentine provided an update regarding the Veteran's Treatment Court and collaborating with the United Way to assist with transportation resources.
   Currently in the process of scheduling meetings with their staff to discuss further, along with other ways to coordinate services for Veterans.
