



CARROLL COUNTY'S SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

METAL



Empty food and beverage cans. Lightly rinsed.

GLASS



Empty bottles and jars. Lightly rinsed, no lid.

PAPER



Clean, dry paper, cartons, and cardboard.

PLASTIC*



Empty bottles, tubs, jars, and jugs. Lightly rinsed, leave lid.

DO NOT BAG!

Materials must be loose!
Plastic bags should never be in the bin.

*PLASTIC RECYCLING TIPS

*Recycle plastics by shape:

- bottles (i.e. water, salad dressing, shampoo)
- jars (items with screw-on lids, i.e. peanut butter, hand cream)
- jugs (items with a molded handle, i.e. milk, detergent)
- tubs (typically with snap-on lids, i.e. margarine, coffee)
- to-go cups (#5 only, empty, throw out lid and straw)

**WHEN IN DOUBT,
LEAVE IT OUT!**

DO NOT PUT THESE ITEMS IN A CURBSIDE BIN

Other drop-off recycling programs may exist,
but none of these should be put in a curbside bin.

When in doubt, leave it out!

Symbols on packages do not reflect local recycling capabilities.
Unacceptable items cause more harm than good.



NO RECYCLING IN BAGS!

Loose materials only.



NO PLASTIC BAGS

Return recyclable bags
to retail drop-offs.



NO SOILED CARDBOARD OR PAPER

(such as pizza boxes)



NO PLASTIC BINS OR HINGED CONTAINERS

(such as produce bins, berry
boxes, and take-out containers)



NO FOOD WRAPPERS, BOX LINERS, PLASTIC FILM, OR "AIR PILLOWS"



NO SHREDDED PAPER

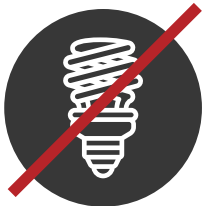


NO "TANGLERS"

(hoses, cords, chains,
twine, rope, holiday lights, etc.)



NO PAPER TOWELS, NAPKINS, OR WET/DIRTY PAPER



NO CFLS, LIGHT BULBS, FLUORESCENT TUBES

Return to most home
improvement stores.



NO BATTERIES OF ANY KIND



NO STRAWS OR BEVERAGE LIDS



NO GLASSES, PLATES, OR CUTLERY OF ANY KIND



NO TRASH, FOOD, DIAPERS, YARD WASTE



NO "STYROFOAM" (Polystyrene, #6)
