We continue to reserve one court on Wednesday mornings from 9:30 am to 10:30 am for beginners up to level 2.5 (0-2.5). When checking in each day at the front desk, remember to select the group you are playing (Beginner/Intermediate or Advanced). It's important to check in so the Center knows the amount of people that use the facility (gym).

The Pickleball Theory Class on Thursday afternoon between 1:00 PM and 2:30 PM for beginners is still active. The class is targeting 6 people to sign up by Tuesday of the same week for it to be held. The class will be deferred week to week until at least 6 people sign up. If exceptions occur, you will be contacted. The last two classes late July and early August had a total of 12 people sign up. The class goes over most areas you need to know to become familiar with the game. There is a visual court and net set up so people can see and understand the different explanations of what goes on during a game.
