Carroll County Housing & Community Development administers 786 housing vouchers within the county. In order to be eligible for these vouchers, applicants should:

- Be 18 years old or older.
- Complete and submit a waiting list application online at [www.waitlistcheck.com/MD448](http://www.waitlistcheck.com/MD448) → or request and complete a paper application by calling or visiting our office.
- Live or work in Carroll County. Although individuals living and working elsewhere are welcome to apply, preference is given those living or working in Carroll County.
- Have an “extremely” or “very low” income according to the current set of income limits. →

**MAINSTREAM VOUCHERS (119)**

Housing staff keep an internal list of potential candidates and fill openings as they become available.

- Must be 18-61 years old.
- Must have a documented long-term disability (from appropriate medical professional) impacting work ability.
- Must be referred by an agency/organization.
- Must be eligible for case management services.

**Housing Stability Program Services** – a Housing Stability Coordinator can help participants:

- Look for a place to live.
- Access emergency sheltering.
- Obtain referrals to community resources for health services and employment assistance.
- Receive information about housing services and other programs.
- Complete paperwork for rental assistance and other benefits.
- Take control of their money by providing budgeting tips.
- Learn about their rights and obtain referrals to legal services if facing housing discrimination.
- Access special resources and programs for youth 18 to 24 years old.
