4. FY24 CPA Prioritizations/Discussion/Votes

Youth Homelessness Prioritization: The CCLMB Members voted to prioritize the State's Youth Homelessness priority using a local indicator of number of homeless youth under the Families are Economically Stable result.

- Motion: Kathi Green. Second: Scott Yard. Opposed: None.
- 13/15 CCLMB Members voted; all voted in favor of the above Youth Homelessness prioritization.

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<u>Continuation of FY23 CPA Programs & Priorities into FY24</u>: Because we ran out of time in this CCLMB meeting, Board Members voted via email to continue prioritizing and operating the three current CPA programs and their Results, Indicators, and state priorities (see below) into FY24.

- Board Members who are employed with the CPA program providers (CCYSB and Together We Own It) were excluded from the vote, which means only 13 Board Members participated. As of 3:00 pm January 19, 2023, 9 Board Members (69%, which is a majority) voted "Yes" to continue these programs.
- Because we do not know our FY24 CPA budget allocation, this vote did not tie any funding to the programs. This vote was simply to affirm the prioritization and operation of the current CPA programs into FY24.
