

Hampstead Valley 2 & 3

Hampstead Valley 2 is a detention basin constructed in the 1980s located to the west of White Oak Court. This facility drains to Hampstead Valley 3 which was also constructed in the 1980's and is located north of Sycamore Drive which functions as the embankment for the facility. The total drainage area, which includes Hampstead Valley 1, is approximately 66 acres, of which 21 are impervious. The embankment for facility 3 is considered a significant hazard dam.

This project will connect the future Hampstead Valley 1 surface sand filter to the culverts under Sycamore Drive, decommissioning Sycamore Drive as a roadway embankment.
