Notices of public hearings of alleged violations of state law and the Board's rules and regulations are governed by Alcoholic Beverages, Article 4-208 of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rule 2 of the Board's rules and regulations. Article 2-409 requires at least ten days notice before hearings. Rule 2 specifies notice by first class mail or personal delivery. A hearing notice sign is not required to be posted, and notices are not required to be published in newspapers for violation hearings.

This schedule is subject to change.

¹ Filing deadline is the first Friday of each month.

² Agenda is prepared approximately the second Friday of each month.

³ Normal practice is to publish notices the next two Fridays of the month before the next month's scheduled hearing.

⁴ Notices of public hearings for new licenses or transfer of licenses are governed by provisions of Alcoholic Beverages, Article 4-208 of the Annotated Code of Maryland. Although hearing notice signs are not required to be posted on the premises for new licenses or transfers of licenses, the practice is to post a sign coinciding with publication of the first hearing notice.
