

Hello!

We are the Westminster Rescue Mission, a distribution partner of the Maryland Food Bank, and the largest food redistribution organization in Carroll County. As a nonprofit Christian organization, the Westminster Rescue Mission is a community that provides clinical, physical, and spiritual resources to heal the addicted and feed the hungry. Our two ministry programs include the Addiction Healing Center and the Mission Food Program.

Through the Mission Food Program, we provide free, nourishing food directly to our neighbors in need: families, seniors, and anyone who experiences hunger. We also work with more than a dozen local partners like soup kitchens, food pantries, churches, and other organizations that redistribute free food in their neighborhoods.

We operate a free weekly drive-thru food pantry on Tuesdays & Fridays from 10-11am on our main campus at 658 Lucabaugh Mill Road. Anyone is welcome. No ID or paperwork required.

At this location, we also distribute nutritious, high-quality USDA Foods through TEFAP (The Emergency Food Assistance Program) to patrons eligible for this federal program. Staff and volunteers are available to assess TEFAP eligibility during our drive-thru pantry hours.

Our off-campus free monthly food distributions include:

1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of the month @ 3:45pm in Hampstead at Hampstead's Little Free Pantry at St. John's United Methodist Church (1205 N. Main Street).

2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month @ 3:45pm in Taneytown in the parking lot behind McDonald's (520 E. Baltimore Street).

3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month @ 5pm in Finksburg at Sandy Mount United Methodist Church (2101 Old Westminster Pike).

4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month @ 3:45pm in Eldersburg in the rear parking lot of Eldersburg Commons (6400 Ridge Road).
