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Affidavit Cottage Industry

Cottage Industry in the Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, Chapters 158.002 and 158.071.02 (A)(13):

Cottage Industry: Manufacturing or assembly conducted by a member or members of the family residing on the property with no more than two nonresident employees. A *COTTAGE INDUSTRY* is not a *HOME OCCUPATION*.

Cottage Industry, provided that it is conducted by a resident within the dwelling or within an accessory building which does not exceed 2,000 square feet in area, subject to Zoning Administrator approval following submittal of a signed affidavit stating that the use meets all applicable requirements:

- A. The use shall not include inventory or merchandise that is sold directly to the public on the premises.
- B. The use shall not change the external appearance of the dwelling or be visible from the street.
- C. The use shall not include any outside storage or display, other than a sign not exceeding three square feet.
- D. The use shall not create a hazard to any person or property.
- E. The use shall not result in electrical interference.
- F. The use shall not become a nuisance.
