#### 1. Request for Proposal (RFP) Update

- The RFP process has begun.
- Mike Beczkowski is collecting data from Lincoln Financial and will use Catapult for scoring the responses.

# 3. Lincoln Financial Cybersecurity Review

## **Market Commentary**

Presented by Mike Beczkowski (JP Morgan Report)

#### Valuations:

The S&P 500 forward P/E ratio increased to 23.1x, the highest since 2000. Elevated valuations are largely driven by the "Magnificent 7" stocks.

#### • Market Concentration:

The top 10 stocks now represent approximately 42% of the S&P 500 (as of 10/29/2025).

#### • Consumer Sentiment:

Sentiment declined to 53.6, indicating growing consumer concerns.

#### Labor Market:

Employment trends are lagging the 10-year average. Unemployment rose to 4.5% from 4.2% the previous quarter.

#### • Inflation:

Increased to 3.0% from 2.7% the previous quarter.

#### Tariffs:

Year-to-date effective tariff rates rose to 6.2% (from 4.7%). Statutory rates increased from 30% (8/8/25) to 35% (10/29/25).

## Federal Reserve:

Interest rates were reduced twice in September and October by 25 basis points each, bringing the range to 3.75%–4.00%.

Inflation risks remain tilted upward while employment risks are tilted downward.

#### Plan Assets:

Combined plan assets reached a record \$103,762,088 as of September 2025 for its all-time high.

#### Asset Allocation:

Approximately 15%–26% of participants remain invested in Target Date Funds.
