

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO PURCHASE
AN AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION EASEMENT**

The Board of County Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland, announces its intent to purchase Agricultural Land Preservation Easements affecting the following properties through the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation matching funds program, which will pay 60 percent of the cost so long as the County pays the remaining 40 percent. Dollar amounts are not yet available however, the County cost-share amount shall not exceed an annually budgeted \$1.333 million for the total of 200+/- acres unless further public notice and Commissioner approval is given.

- 1) 102.54 acres of land, located at 7433 Woodbine Rd., Woodbine, Maryland, 21797, from Aloha Farm, LLC.
- 2) 111.43 acres of land, located at 3001 Flag Marsh Rd., Mt. Airy, Maryland, 21771, from Edward Harrison and Jill Turner.
- 3) 25.2183 acres of land, located at 5701 Bethel Rd., Woodbine, Maryland, 21797, from Karen Hecht and Gregory Eaton.

The County Commissioners will decide whether to purchase these easements at a public meeting which is to be held no sooner than fifteen (15) days from the date this notice appears.
