The Piney Run Recreation and Conservation Council is dedicated to supporting Piney Run Park and Nature Center. With the focus on conservation and environmental education, many programs and activities held throughout the year are promoted and offered by the Piney Run Council. Income from these programs and events as well as Nature Center memberships helps the Council provide support for our resident critters, exhibits, the Piney Run Summer Nature Camp, college scholarships (see below) and kayaking instruction as well as other programs, projects and activities to benefit the Park and Nature Center and for the enjoyment of our visitors.

Our new Park Naturalist, Basil Levesque, has been very busy researching the habitat requirements for each of our resident critters and with the Council's financial support, has been upgrading those exhibits for the benefit of our critters. And with a grant from MAEOE, Basil and the park staff are building a new enclosure for our black rat snake, Kaa, which will be in the Nature Center Children's Room. The Council also has an <u>Amazon Wish List</u> of items we need that can be purchased and donated to help offset our animal care expenses.

The council was able to host numerous fundraising activities and events last year and will continue doing so this year. We appreciate all who attended our 3rd annual Piney Run Park Fall Festival last Fall despite the uncooperative weather. This year's Fall Festival will be held on Saturday, October 12th, with a rain date of October 13th. Our upcoming Council events include our Spring Fever Coffeehouse on Friday, March 22nd with the Koons' family musical band, WHIRLIGIG; an Apple Basket Basketweaving Class on Saturday, May 4th; and our Celebrate Spring Event and Spring Perennial Swap both on Saturday, May 11th. Since park programs thrive on new ideas, input from additional people is always welcome and encouraged by the Council. All Council meetings are open to the public. Any member of the Nature Center is automatically a member of the Council, but must attend two Council meetings within the previous 12 months (and be 18 years of age) in order to vote at these meetings. Council meetings are held bi-monthly on the 3rd Thursday in January, March, May, July, September, and November at 6:30 p.m. typically in the Piney Run Nature Center. At these meetings updates from Park Staff and Council members are presented and discussed, decisions are made about fundraising events, and how membership and fundraising money is spent for the benefit of the Park and Nature Center. Scholarship Program Information

In alignment with the Piney Run Recreation and Conservation Council's strong belief in education, two \$1,500 scholarships have been created to help students with college education related expenses.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a member, a child of a member, or under guardianship of a member of the Piney Run Nature Center.
- Applicant must be a full-time student taking undergraduate courses or in the final year of high school and
 planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited college or university recognized by the <u>U.S.</u>
 <u>Department of Education</u> in the current year.
- The same individual cannot win this scholarship in two consecutive years.

Scholarship Application: Complete and sign the Scholarship Application.

- Applicant must have a non-related adult sponsor who is not an employee at Piney Run Park provide a letter
 of recommendation or complete the Applicant Appraisal section of the application.
- A minimum grade point average (or equivalent) of 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0) official transcript required.

Requirements Checklist - Each qualified student must submit the following items:

- Transcript and Scores (official transcripts must be in original sealed envelopes):
 High school student applicants should deliver the Transcript Section to the school's principal or guidance counselor to complete, sign, and return to the applicant in a sealed envelope, along with an official
 - College student applicants need to provide an official college transcript.

□ Recommendation/Appraisal:

transcript.

- Obtain a letter of recommendation from a non-related adult appraiser (one who is not an employee at Piney Run Park, such as a high school or college counselor or advisor, instructor, professional person, or supervisor).
- Or have non-related appraiser complete the Applicant Appraisal section of the application.
- Written statement: Prepare a statement explaining why the scholarship is deserved and how it will help. Consider explaining how you became interested in nature, why your intended major is important to you, describing your experiences or involvement with Piney Run Park and/or sharing how this scholarship will help improve your financial situation. (No more than one typewritten double-spaced page.)
- Return all of the above in a single envelope (Transcript and Letter of Recommendation/Applicant Appraisal sections must be in their own sealed envelopes) postmarked no later than April 10th, 2024 to:

Selection Process

The Piney Run Recreation and Conservation Council Scholarship Committee has the sole responsibility for selecting award recipients on behalf of the Council, based on a combination of factors. Once the initial academic requirements are met, the student's involvement with Piney Run Park, school, community and environmental activities, work experience, the statement submitted by the student, and appraisal (by the adult sponsor) will be considered.
