## **EMS Policies and Procedures**

## I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

Carroll County Department of Fire and EMS (DFEMS) main goal is to staff EMS units throughout the county.

II. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

None

- III. <u>PROCEDURES</u>
  - A. The department realizes that there will be a need to down staff the EMS units to provide adequate staffing for fire suppression units and rescue units throughout the county.
  - B. The Volunteer Chiefs, Shift Commanders and the Station Lieutenants shall have the ability to deviate from this policy with just cause.
  - C. Incident Commanders shall consider requesting additional fire suppression units in order to keep EMS staffing available.
  - D. Stations that have two staffed transport units in service, in the case of first-due response only:
    - a. One ALS transport unit shall remain in service and available for dispatched calls.
    - b. The second transport unit shall be used in one of two ways depending on call type:
      - i. Second ambulance may respond with the fire suppression apparatus to meet staffing requirements, however, shall remain in service and aware to the possibility of diverting for a second EMS call in their first due.
        - 1. Fire Alarms
        - 2. Check on welfare
        - 3. Routine service alarms

- ii. Second ambulance may split crew and have one person to increase suppression staffing while the EMS unit responds to the scene with the suppression piece.
  - 1. This shall only be for first due box area and limited to call types such as
    - a. Box Alarm
    - b. Local Alarm with increased possibility of working fire.
  - 2. Once the suppression unit is placed in service the EMS crew shall return to the EMS unit and be available for EMS response.
- E. Stations with one staffed ambulance.
  - a. EMS unit may split crew and have one person to increase suppression staffing while the EMS unit responds to the scene with suppression piece.
  - b. Once the suppression unit is placed in service the EMS crew shall return to the EMS unit and be available for EMS response.

## IV. <u>RECISION</u>

This Standard Operating Procedure rescinds all directives regarding EMS Unit Staffing or similar content previously issued for personnel of the Carroll County Department of Fire and EMS.
